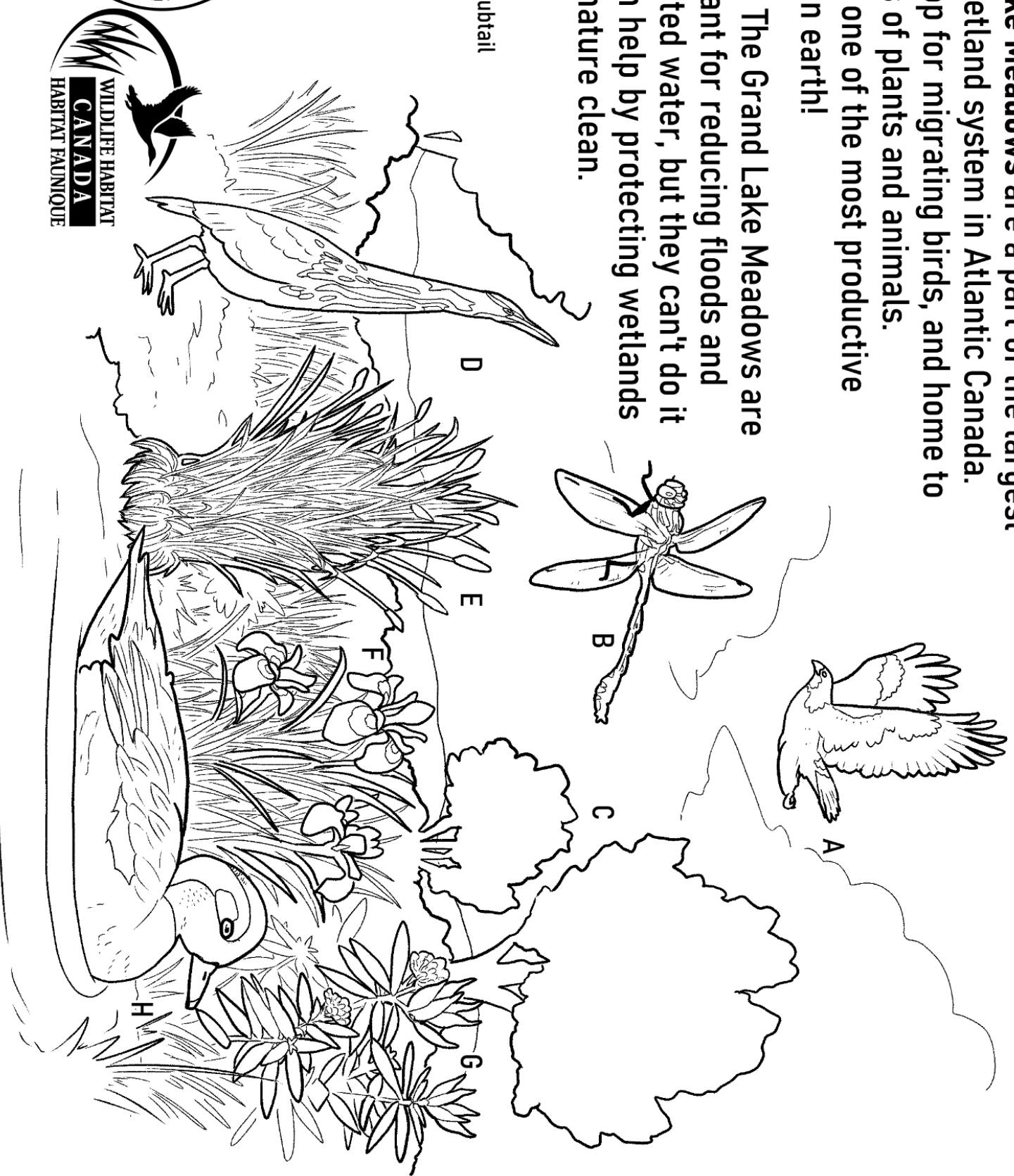

I am a **Hooded Merganser**. My brother and I both have a crest on our heads, but his has a big white patch.

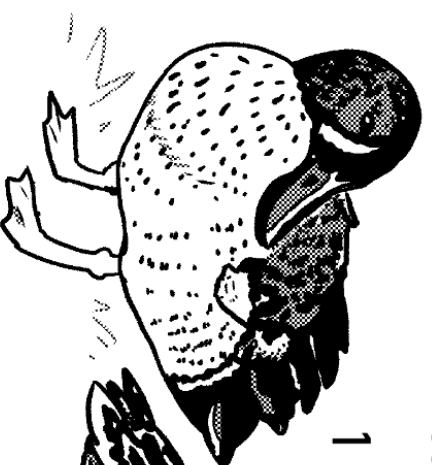
I am a **Blue-Winged Teal**. Unlike me, my partner has a white stripe between his eye and bill.
